



# Get Ready For Your Party

- Create your party invitations for your guests at <https://www.revo-ice.com/birthday-parties/invitation/>
- Guests should plan to arrive 10-15 minutes prior to scheduled party time.
- A member of the party staff will be at the front desk to share your room assignment and location.
- You have two options; eat before skating or after skating.
- Please let the rink know what time you want the pizza delivered.
- If you are eating before your party, your party host will serve your guests pizza, drinks and any other food items ordered followed by present opening (should you choose).
- The party host will distribute skating passes in the party room to those participants in the public skate session and those guests will proceed to the skate rental counter to retrieve their skates.
- If you have reserved a skating instructor, skaters interested in participating in the lesson will be introduced to your Skating Instructor 5-10 minutes prior to the lesson.
- Your party host will meet the guest of honor in the party room to escort him/her to the side of the rink during the intermission ice cut to get a picture on the Zamboni.
- If you are eating after your skating session, your party host will serve your guests pizza, cake, drinks and any food items ordered followed by present opening (should you choose).
- We provide all tablecloths, paper plates, napkins, paper cups and utensils.
- You may bring your own paper products and decorations - just let us know before the day of the party. We do, however, ask that you do not attach anything to the walls or ceiling of the party room. No Silly String or confetti or table top glitter/confetti permitted. You will have 1 hour total time (30 minutes before public skate and 30 minutes after public skate) in the private party room, so you may want to recruit friends to help decorate. Public skate is 90 minutes.
- You are allowed to bring cake or cupcakes (no other outside food or drink permitted)
- You are permitted to bring balloons
- Prior to the party, each guest should complete an online registration and waiver at <https://waiver.smartwaiver.com/w/5bc4bc0dabea4/web/>
- Rink temperatures average 40-60 degrees. Our lobby averages 70 degrees. Dress in warm, comfortable clothing that will not restrict movement (and dress in layers). Dressing in layers gives you the option of removing a layer if you get too warm. Long pants and gloves or mittens recommended. Hats and helmets are recommended for beginner skaters.
- You must wear socks to rent skates. One pair of tall, thin socks is recommended.
- We recommend bringing a bicycle helmet for children and adults alike.
- The smallest size skates we carry are child Size 6 Figure Skate (usually fits children around 3 years old).
- We provide The Skate Helper skating aids which enhance the ice skating experience for parents with kids who don't know how to skate. Parents don't have to strain their back trying to hold their child up. The Skate Helper skating aids give children the confidence they need to stand up on skates and get their balance.
- Gratuity is NOT included in the cost of the party. Typical gratuity is a percentage of the bill and equivalent to what you would tip a server in a restaurant.
- Each guest at the party goes home with a party favor bag and a free skate pass valued at \$8.00
- Revolution provides a knife, birthday candles and a lighter.
- We don't offer party booking refunds, but we're happy to reschedule your birthday party.
